To create a structured and professional platform for identifying and promoting young Cameroonian football talents while strengthening cooperation between Cameroonian football institutions and international football stakeholders.



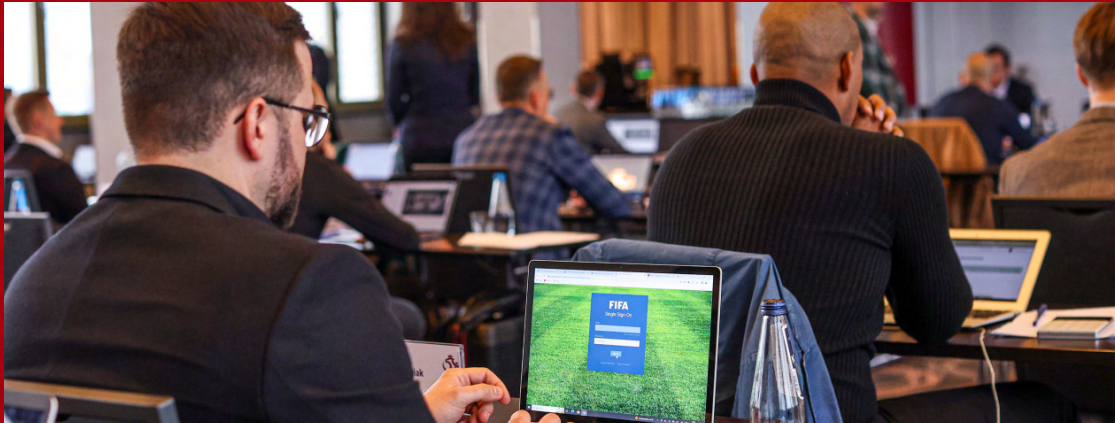
2.2 Specific Objectives

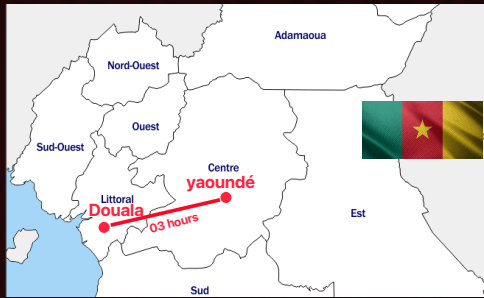

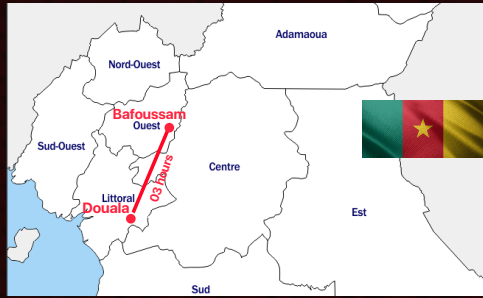

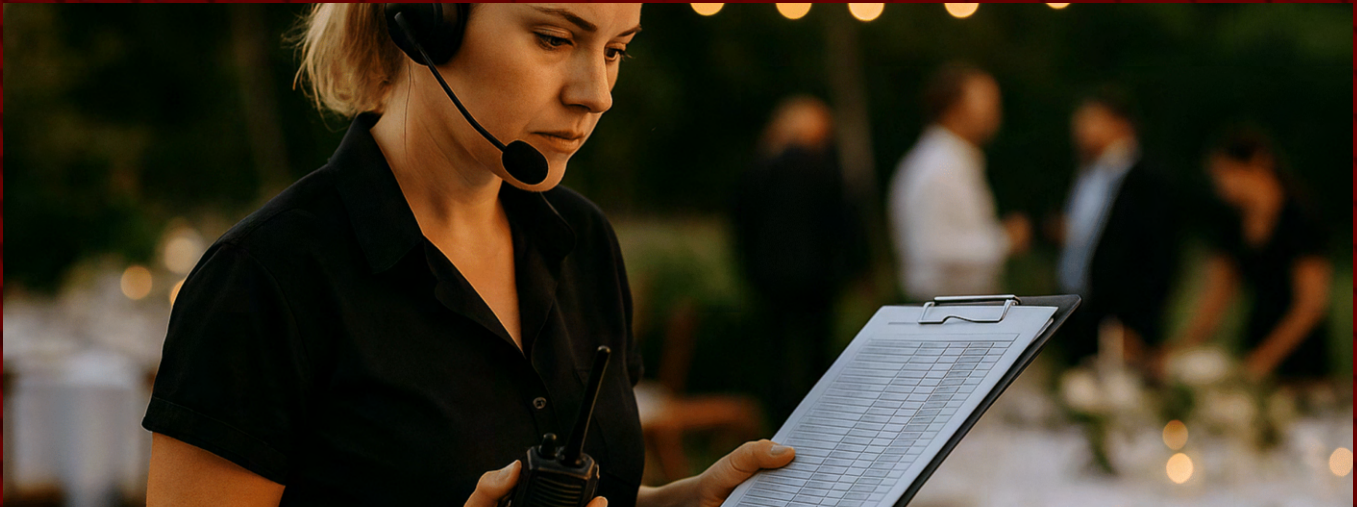
